

Curbside Brush and Bulk Waste Collection Program

The following types of brush and bulk waste will be collected from the parkways of residential properties **whose owner/occupants participate in the City of Bloomington refuse billing program:**

Bulk Waste, including...

- Household and patio furniture
- General household remodeling debris from within the home generated by the homeowner/occupant only
- Trash resulting from cleaning out basements/garages by owners/occupants
- Exterior house and yard renovation/replacement debris from work on fences, driveways, sidewalks, foundations, porches, roofs, and windows, but only if the work is done by the owner/occupant

Brush or Landscape Waste, including...

- Tree removal
- Tree limb/branch trimmings
- Leaves
- Firewood
- Bush removal
- Bush trimmings
- Ornamental flowers

Curbside Bulk/Brush Waste collection crews **will not collect any waste (bulk or brush) generated by:**

- Businesses
- Contractors
- Persons for hire
- Employees of property owners
- Any person being compensated for work that generates the bulk or brush waste

The following types of waste **will not be collected by city crews:**

- Tires
- Batteries
- Hazardous materials
- Liquids
- Oil
- Chemicals
- Grass clippings or thatch
- Appliances
- Paint in liquid form
- **Bagged** leaves or brush

Take Pride in Your Parkway !!

Please put bulk waste and brush at the back of the curb no earlier than the day before your collection day.

To determine which day brush and bulk waste are picked up at your address, please call Public Service at 434-2220 between 7 a.m. and 2 p.m. weekdays.

Bulk waste, such as furniture, should be placed carefully at the back of the curb and should not block the sidewalk



Keep limbs and branches from extending into the street, where they could cause safety problems for motorists

Upon entering the drop-off facility from East Street, stop at the attendant's post and check-in



There is a drop-off bay for bulk waste such as furniture and remodeling debris



There is also a drop-off bay for brush only and one for grass and leaves only

Public Service Drop-off Facility **402 S. East Street**

The drop-off facility is available to owners and occupants of residential property **who participate in Bloomington's refuse billing program**. The facility can be used to dispose of waste items prior to or after regularly scheduled collection by city crews. For hours of operation, please call the Public Service office at 434-2220 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. weekdays.

The drop-off facility accepts all bulk, brush and landscape waste items collected curbside, and also accepts:

- Appliances
- Propane tanks **with the valve removed**
- Grass clippings and thatch

The drop-off facility will not accept debris generated by:

- Businesses
- Contractors
- Persons for hire
- Employees of property owners
- Any person being compensated for work that generates the brush/bulk waste

The drop-off facility does not accept:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Hazardous materials
- Liquids
- Oil
- Chemicals
- Paint in liquid form
